Respected Sir,

The Real Estate industry in the MMR region has been under tremendous stress for the last 5 -6 years. The demonetization of the currency, Introduction of GST, enactment of RERA in the State, and now this lockdown due to the COVID-19 pandemic has resulted in a further slowdown in the Industry. Further, the NBFC crisis has led to a liquidity crunch in the economy.

On various occasions, the Industry has prayed for Government support with definite measures. We appreciate that our concerns have been heard by the State Government. Out of our several demands, the State Government and especially the Revenue Ministry vide their GR dated 29.08.2020 accepted our demand of rebate on the Stamp Duty for Real Estate transactions by 3% upto 31.12.2020 and by 2% from 01.01.2021 till 31.03.2021. We again **thank you for reducing the Stamp duty rates** on Real Estate transactions.

This measure has spurred home purchases in the MMR region. About <u>11.4 lakhs</u> registrations and collection of over Rs. 8000 crores have been reported by Municipal Commissioner of Mumbai in CNBC interview. This is an increase of 2.7 lakhs registration over the figures for October 2019.

HDFC Limited has reported a 35% increase in the disbursement of Home loans over the figures reported for October 2019. The data on registration, revenue collection and home loans is testimony to an uptick in the State Economy. We need to maintain this momentum.

The positive sentiments of the home buyers and resulting home purchases will increase the cash flows of the Real estate developers, increase revenues, lead to higher creation of jobs, higher tax collections for the State. Real Estate has been 2nd largest employer and supports around 270 ancillary industries. This will create a positive cycle for investment and ultimately **revival of the Economy of Maharashtra**.

Also, some of our customers are not able to decide to buy due to uncertainty in the Jobs market and partial lockdown conditions, a further extension will give them time to take their decision and buy their dream homes.

Also, we would have to maintain social distancing and avoid a huge rush at Registration Offices. This could be achieved if the rebate is continued for a further 3 months post 31st December 2020.
