a.	Advice to be obtained from Shri Parimal Shroff whether MCHI-CREDAI should intervene in the Kohinoor SLP in Supreme Court.
	It was informed by President Shri Vimal Shah that the State of Maharashtra has filed affidavit in Supreme Court. It was further pointed out by President that so far the MCGM has not taken any steps to finalize the affidavit and this is the most worrying things. It is learnt that this SLP is likely to be decided in this month.
b.	In ULC Matters conference were held with Advocates Shri Nivit Srivastava, Shri Milind Sathe and Shri Pravin Samdhani as matters were listed for final hearing on August 30, 2013. Conference is also held with Sr. Counsel Shri Shekhar Naphade on August 28 in Delhi. Now it is learnt that Justice Shri Dhananjay Dahanukar is not sitting on August 29 & August 30.
	In ULC matter the Hon'ble High Court will fix the date or hearing and this matter also likely to be disposed expeditiously.
