1	Supreme Court Judgment in Kohinoor Matter and other related issues
	<p>This meeting was fixed mainly to discuss various issues arising out off the Supreme Court judgment</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Whether we should file Review Petition or not? 2) What steps on what grounds? 3) If no review petition is filed what hardship will be cause builders community? <p>Shri Vimalbhai pointed out that the main issue in the judgment is the formation of committee headed by retired judge. The terms of reference is decided by Hon'ble Court itself.</p> <p>Thus scope committee is too wide. Any person can file complain on any one of the grievances listed. There is no Appellate Authority prescribed to challenge the findings of the committee. In case of the demised of any one of the members the vacancy could be filled through Supreme Court.</p> <p>There are series of Supreme Court judgments where in the committees formed by High Court are set aside.</p> <p>And here the Supreme Court has formed a committee which is not a fact-finding committee. After discussing all the angle it was unanimous view of core committee to file Interveners Application through M/s. Parimal Shroff and Co. Who will take steps in consultation with Sr. Counsel in Delhi.</p>
