Sub: Request for opening of stone quarries

Dear

Please recollect our yesterday's telephonic discussion about various issues being faced by the developers due to closure of all stone quarries in Navi Mumbai area because of environmental issues. However, because of non availability of stones for 2-3 months, which is a vital component of construction material, it is not only affecting the ongoing construction adversely but is also adding to the cost of construction to a very high level of about 40-50%.

This difficulty of non supply of stones in the region, was extensively discussed in our Managing Committee meeting and there is a request on behalf of CREDAI-MCHI that the government, at your level may give the sanction or licences/permits for new stone quarries for construction purpose in order to regulate the prices and help the development of affordable housing in that area. The new quarries and areas could be identified, which may not affect the environmental requirement.


Please expedite the same and help us to control the prices of Housing.
