### A procedure to start subsidised vegetable selling centers

1. To start a subsidised vegetable selling centre APMC activated a toll free No. 1800 22 22 14 and helpline no. 27881400 in their head office at Vashi.
2. After receiving a call from social institutes / Co-operative institutions / Social Trusts / Bachat Gat / person / group a concerned person from APMC head office will take the proper registration in their data base and also provide necessary information about the subsidised vegetable centre.
3. A form with prescribed format enclosed for the concerned, who wish to start subsidised vegetable centre.
4. After receiving the form with proper information, it is handed over to the concerned officers of various divisions in Mumbai. After confirming the site for the vegetable centre according to the data filled in application, this application sent to the committee of APMC with recommendation of concerned divisional officer.
5. After discussing all the issues of the subsidised vegetable centre in Steering Committee, it proceeds to the next implementation step.
6. All concerned centers are informed to register their demands. Along with the registration they are informed to pay the fixed vegetable rate for the centre.
7. After the payment of the cost, next day the vegetables are supplied by vehicles to the respective centers.
8. APMC has appointed one staff independently who goes along with the vehicle and he stays at vegetable centre till closing time.
9. The vegetables are carried in the crates provided by APMC. These vegetables are purchased by the **Wholesaler Trade Mahasangh** and it's also distributed by them only.
10. The empty crates taken back by the APMC by same vehicle on next day.
