		Shri D. J. Khambata, Advocate General has given the opinion on the issue of redevelopment of buildings which have already use TDR. It is opined that TDR is given to the owner in lieu of serenading land to public body for public purpose. TDR is permanent benefit arising out of land, therefore computing FSI for redevelopment the TDR quantum should be consider along with basic FSI of the plot. In short the developer/ owner will be entitled to have the benefit of used TDR for redevelopment.				
		President, Shri Vimal Shah said that this opinion should be followed further at committee level. It was further informed not to circulate this opinion.
