		Given instruction to file Writ Petition	
		Though this provision affects everybody, only two comments are received on this subject, one from our President & the other from Hon. Secretary. The directions were given to go ahead for filing Petition. Instructions are given to M/s. Parimal K. Shroff & Co.	
	ii	20% EWS	
	11	Whether to intervene in the D B Realty Petition or wait for the order?	
		It was informed that the authorities are insisting that 20% must be provided in each project otherwise they are not accepting or clearing our projects. It was informed that on 16th or 17th April, final order is expected in the Writ Petition filed by M/s. D B Realty.	
		President directed to file separate, independent Writ Petition and not to get tagged with others. Parimalbhai or some other advocate may be approached. Shri C. P. Goyal has been asked to keep three sets ready of the petition filed by M/s. D B Realty.

3.	Liais	son Matter :
	i.	Doppler Weather Radar CEO MCHI-CREDAI written a DO letter to Hon'ble Chief Secretary on March 28, 2014 related to the subject of placement of additional Doppler Weather Radar in Mumbai. Disaster management unit of State Government is arranging a joint inspection on April 17, 2014 at 11.30 am of proposed building sites for setting up secondary Doppler Radar for Mumbai. Finalize Writ Petition and engage senior counsel, simultaneously It was informed that as per our request by D.O. letter to Hon'ble Chief Secretary, a joint inspection of the suggested buildings have been fixed on April 17, 2014 at 11:00 am for setting up secondary Doppler Radar for Mumbai.
		We should also inform them whether Repeater Radar would be technically useful and feasible for getting relevant data in this regard and should be informed accordingly. Check up whether in our proposal, Yeoor Hills, where Air Force station Road is located, has been suggested as place for Doppler Radar. The directions were given to finalise Writ Petition and engage Senior Counsel simultaneously.
	ii.	Formulation of Technically Advisory Committee (TAC) MCGM form a TAC under the Chairmanship of Ex-director of MCGM. The formulation of any policy towards DCR is dealt with Development Plan Dept. and policies, guidelines, circulars in this respect are also issued. Shri Avadhoot Rane was asked to list out issues for this committee (TAC) and provide it to Shri Nayan Shah, Vice President, who will write to Mr. Kale, member of the committee about the same.
