Heard learned counsel for both the sides.

There is delay of about 3 to 4 days in preferring the appeal.

Learned counsel for applicant submits that there is no deliberate or intentional delay on the part of appellant in preferring appeal. She submits that there was some technical difficulty in filing online appeal and hence, delay was caused.
