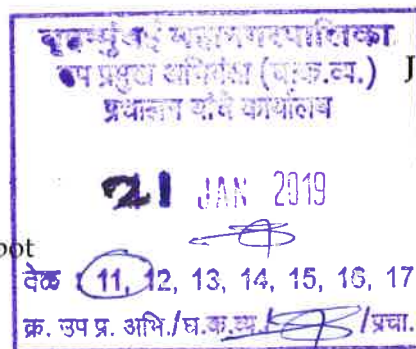

Sub : Finding New sites for unloading C&D waste material

Dear Sir,

With reference to the aforementioned letter, please accept our sincere apologies for the delay in our reply.

CREDAI-MCHI has and would always support MCGM In all its initiatives. On the SWM matter as well, MCHI would be very happy to support you I'm identifying additional dumping sites and would definitely become a facilitator and a catalyst in getting such land parcels. However, this exercise can at best be a joint exercise.

Sir, let us first take stock of the existing sites where there could be unutilized capacity available, which should be taken note of. Also, we very strongly feel that MCGM is in the best position to have a land bank record or identify land parcels for dumping purposes. Sir, should MCGM have such land parcel details available, we would earnestly request for the same to be shared with us. CREDAI-MCHI shall in due course establish contact with the land owner and seek their NOC.

Sir, it is also our humble request that MCGM should take out a Public Advertisement inviting land owners to come forward and make their land parcels available for dumping of solid waste. Also if a joint meeting with excavation contractors can be called for where we all could work together to find a permanent solution to this matter; this would enable us to get future sites in an ongoing continuous manner.

Meanwhile, as per instructions from Monitoring Committee to MCGM for CREDAI-MCHI, we have already written to all our members inviting proposals for land parcels that could be used for C & D waste. Please be apprised that we have already received a proposal from one member with the site in Virar. Also we are in process of giving public Advertisement inviting landowner with their proposal for using their land for Disposal for C & D waste. It's a time consuming process so kind request to give us some time to collect the details

Finally, We will have a joint meeting with list of sites available with MCGM and the list of sites collected by CREDAI-MCHI to discuss and finalize the Sites to submitted.

We would also like to highlight a circular issued by your department, wherein it is clearly mentioned that even the owner or representative of the unloading sites need

to submit a bank guarantee. Sir, our humble request is that if this condition could be removed, as all the land owners may not be able to afford this and they may shy away from giving their respective land for C & D waste disposal.

We once again reiterate that CREDAI-MCHI has always been cooperating with MCGM and would continue doing so. We look forward to your kind advice and way forward on this.
