
Dear

Please recall our last meeting held on 20<sup>th</sup> September, 2013 in your chamber and our telephonic call held on 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2013, with reference to the subject of Royalty Excavation.

I met Shri Sanjay Deshmukh (IAS), Collector and Addl. Collector of Mumbai Suburban District on 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2013 regarding issue of Royalty Excavation on behalf of MCHI-CREDAI inspite of the ad interim stay from the Hon'ble High Court. In above meeting MCHI-CREDAI urged the Collector about difficulties being faced by our members in royalty payments etc. even during the interim period and after Government letter. The Collector assured us that he will seek clarification from the Revenue Department to solve the confusing interpretation on technical grounds. The royalty and penalty are being charged contrary to the Government orders of Revenue Department and High Court order dated 5<sup>th</sup> September, 2011.

Hence, I will be grateful if you will inform the concerned officers of the districts to resolve this matter at the earliest which will be crucial for our MCHI-CREDAI Members. There could be issue of the contempt of Hon'ble High Court if proper interpretation and meanings are not adhered to.
