Sub: Obligatory duty of the MCGM to construct and maintain amenities including small Nallas

Respected Sir,

In this current Covid situation, the development activities has come to stand still and same is the case with the redevelopment activities. We would appreciate that unless and until Government comes forward and resolves the long pending issues nothing significant will happen. Sir you are aware that the result and effect of halting the economic activities on jobs and the tax earnings. Not only state but also mahanagar palika will be affected and hence we are requesting you to intervene in this matter.

There are numerous smaller and bigger issues for which MCGM is not taking any decisions and are delaying the matter with the pretext that it will have impact on their financials. This is irrespective of fact whether it is within or against the law. This results in affected parties and MCGM both taking the legal route thereby increasing legal expenses, long and lengthy legal procedures results in slowdown of economic activities.

As per the various court rulings and also as per the clause 61(a) of MMC Act it is obligatory duty of MCGM to construct and maintain nalla. The same cannot be passed or diverted to anyone else. Futhrer, MCGM has issued the circulars and are charging various fees / premiums from developer for the nalla construction and retention walls. But as per the MRTP act it should have been approved by the Urban Development Department. In this case, circular has been issued without the approval of the Government of Maharashtra. Moreover, in some cases MCGM has constructed the nalla at their cost and in some cases they want to recover it for the people who want to develop the land at their cost. There are lot of other issues which our members are confronting with MCGM but not yet resolved.

We request you to instruct the MCGM authorities to not to insist for any charges for retention of nalla or for construction of the nalla wall which is otherwise illegal. Under your dynamic leadership we are positive that such long pending issues will be resolved and it will grant us some relief during this current pandemic scenario.
