Sub: Request for minor corrections in IT/ITeS Policy 2015 and its Expeditiously Implementation.

Dear

We appreciated the initiative taken by you and your office first mainly in issuance of 37(1) (A) in IT/ITeS policy which issued on 10th December 2015. More importantly you also have taken the inclusion of BFSI as per the earlier policy.

To quickly implement IT policy announced in August 2015 in Mumbai, we in MCHI request the following:

- 1. BFSI services users to be added in the ITeS services, as available in earlier IT policy
- 2. Maximum Cap of FSI for Mumbai City area to be 4 in place of capping of 3.
- 3. Property taxes to be 50% discount for IT building.
- 4. Urban Development Department could announced by GR of IT policy published with above amendments during Make in India on 13th February 2016, to give tremendous boost to investments in Maharashtra.

Therefore, we request you, since State of Maharashtra is one of the leading IT/ITeS corridors of India, it will be appreciable if government will approve the above mentioned points before "Make in India" week which is going to start on 13th February 2016 in Mumbai.

Looking forward for the positive necessary action to take the desired steps in implementing the same please.
