	To Do List: Avadhoot: RTI application to be made seeking information regarding average delay of the clearances of the projects from the date of the submission of the application, duration of pendency, delay and date of order of the clearances.
	Environment: the order of Madras High Court should be got hold on and request CIC and the respective Planning Authorities and Local Bodies like, Municipal Commissioner, CEO-MHADA, Chief Engineer (DP) to consider and implement the directions in that High Court order while implementing RTI Act.
	Request letter to be written to the Secretary, Industries (IT) for holding discussions, seminars on IT Policy, either in Government or in our office.
	Reminder to the members through SMSs etc. for Contribution of Legal Fund.
	Tarun: Welcome Letter – points to be included in the letter to the Managing Committee Members' deliverables, tasks assigned which will be reviewed monitoring to ease their involvement, participation and contribution.
	Website: Streamlining the site and structure has been designed, however, data uploading, Operation maintenance charges, costs, logging etc. All timeliness to be fixed, e-share for members benchmarking, ranking etc. For each work, the facility should be provided to the members like free for three months, free of charge so that they get used to the system with the password, logging system etc.

	Thane TDR: Apprehension/doubt that this order may be implemented in whole Maharashtra and not limited to Only Mumbai & Thane.
	ULC- SLP: Email to all members that to appoint Senior Counsel in Supreme Court is very expensive. As implications are of very high cost. Request all who are affected, to come forward and help in filing SLP by MCHI in the Supreme Court. We have no fund in Legal Account.
