		Avadhoot: RTI application to be made seeking information regarding average delay of the clearances of the projects from the date of the submission of the application, duration of pendency, delay and date of order of the clearances.
		Environment: the order of Madras High Court should be got hold on and request CIC and the respective Planning Authorities and Local Bodies like, Municipal Commissioner, CEO-MHADA, Chief Engineer (DP) to consider and implement the directions in that High Court order while implementing RTI Act.
		Request letter to be written to the Secretary, Industries (IT) for holding discussions, seminars on IT Policy, either in Government or in our office.
