Greetings from MCHI-CREDAI!

We had a fruitful meeting with the Principal Secretary of Environment Department on June 23, 2015 to discuss the issues concerning Environmental Clearances with respect to Real Estate Development.

MCHI-CREDAI already requested to the Principal Secretary of the department that the Environmental Clearances of all the proposals to be taken up for hearing by the Environmental Committee (SEAC-II) for Mumbai & MMR should always be in chronological order in accordance with the Office Memorandum No.J11013/41/2006-IA.II(I) dated 18th May 2012 issued by the Central Government. Copy of which is enclosed herewith.

As the Committee was formed almost after 9 months, there are backlog of more than 1000 cases. Further few cases were submitted at Delhi, which are also now transferred to Maharashtra. Further due to change in DC Regulation like Fungible, Supreme Court Order, minor change in plan etc., old cases, where MOEF clearance granted are being resubmitted for amendment.

Our request is to have committee meetings continuously or regular weekly meetings to clear the huge backlog, pendency cases. Further, even in ease of doing business, we have been requesting the Government to clear the pendency cases. This will enable the Developers to start their projects.

Hence, on behalf of MCHI-CREDAI We would like to request you, to please look into this matter of the Environment Department with keen interest to take up MOEF clearance on priority basis.
