The meeting began with the Executive Health Officer, Dr. Arun Bamne welcoming all the participants.


Executive Health Officer began with a power point presentation. He appreciated every single Government and Semi-Government agency for having contributed to the control of Malaria in the last two years. He mentioned that the M.C.G.M. had succeeded in reducing malaria incidence by 50% in the previous two years and the same target needed to be achieved during the year 2014 with joint co-ordinated efforts. He stated that Malaria and Dengue is purely man made due to the various life practices of citizens. He compared incidence of Malaria in different States of India. He stated that Mumbai stand 3rd in comparison to other metro politan cities. He highlighted that entry is not granted to the staff of MCGM in the Navy premises. He stressed that at present Dengue is the real cause of concern and should be jointly tackled as for Malaria.

In the power point presentation E.H.O., took a broad review of all the Government agencies present for the meeting. Insecticide Officer Shri.Rajan Naringrekar took a detailed review of the status of non mosquito proof water storage tanks in all the Govt. and Semi Govt. agencies. He stressed that MCGM is not keen in prosecutions and appealed to all the participants continue their co-ordinated joint efforts. The extract of the review and the directions given by Hon'ble M.C. are as follows :-

- Hon'ble Municipal Commissioner directed the Naval authority to resolve the issue of entry of MCGM staff in their premises. Shri.Abhishek Kumar, G.E. (NW)- Navy stated that this issue will be discussed with Head qrts of Navy and mosquito proofing of all the tanks will be completed.
- Shri.S.S.Hussain,CEO ,MCHI appreciated the efforts taken by MCGM and assured that site corrections and other mosquito control measures will be undertaken at all building construction sites.
- Insecticide Officer agreed to impart training to the staff of all the agencies regarding mosquito control measures and removal of unwanted mosquito genic situations, if they so desired.


- Hon'ble Municipal Commissioner stated that if mosquito control measures are neglected the cost to be paid will be high. He also stated that MCGM has undertaken Mumbai Arogya Abhiyan camps and several other interventions to reduce Malaria and further said that as Malaria is man made failure to manage proper water disposal results in the incidence of the disease. He appeal to all the participants to use the presentation given and train their respective staff to implement mosquito control measures. He stated that the present trend of Dengue incidence through out the year is very dangerous and cause of concern for every one. He appealed all the present to complete mosquito proofing measures before 28th April 2014 and dispose off all the scrap and odd articles, after which joint inspections will be completed upto 30th April 2014. Failure to implement mosquito control measures will result in legal prosecutions. Next review meeting to be held during the month end of May.

The Meeting then concluded with a vote of thanks by Executive Health Officer.
