- 4.2. To encourage, conduct and support activities leading to Universal Spiritual Upliftment as preached by the Tirthankar Bhagwants.
- 4.3. To promote, manage, establish, maintain, encourage, organize and assist in the development and promotion of education which will empower the individual to lead the life in accordance with Truth and high Morality at all levels through setting up / helping educational programmes covering all fields either directly or through establishing trusts or other bodies.
- 4.4. To initiate, encourage, conduct and support all activities leading to General Public Utility for social welfare, cultural upliftment, better health care and economic empowerment of the society at large.
- 4.5. To achieve overall spiritual and cultural upliftment of all by Inspiring and encouraging learning, of Jain Tenets of Truth, Non-violence, Principles of Live and Let Live and Compassion and adopting them as a way of life.
- 4.6. To build, promote, manage, encourage, aid, assist or equip hospitals, dispensaries, diagnostic centers and other institutions engaged in health care and to organize, participate, encourage, undertake, sponsor, promote, assist, run, conduct, hold, guide and manage projects, programs, etc for the purpose of helping and undertaking relief works in case of natural calamities or any other accident or any other mishap or happenings as an act beyond control of mankind.
- 4.7. To promote, maintain and encourage co-operative and friendly feelings and unity and unanimity of views among business community and associations on all subjects connected with the common good and for upliftment of the society at large.
- 4.8. To organize, participate, encourage, undertake, sponsor, promote, assist, run, conduct, hold, guide and manage projects, programs, conferences, symposiums, seminars, workshops, shows, exhibitions, dramas, promotional events, festivals etc. for the purpose of developing and/or promoting the spiritual development of the community/ society at large.
- 4.9. To cultivate reciprocal relations with institutions in India and elsewhere and to associate, collaborate, team-up, partner and co-operate with other agencies, national and international institutions, organizations, Government of India, any state government, public authority, local, municipal or otherwise or with any corporation or trust or non - government organization or Society or private persons or all or any of

these on multi dimensional, multi stakeholder projects that are strategic, innovative and have large scale impact in people's lives or on policy formulation and design and for the purpose of directly or indirectly carrying out or achieving all or any of the objects of the Society.

- 4.10. To accept donation / contributions or otherwise raise money from time to time required for the purpose of the Society by way of issuing bonds, debentures, bills of exchange, promissory notes or other obligations or securities of the Society or mortgage or charge on the property / assets of the Society.
- 4.11. To utilize, deploy, invest the available funds which are not required immediately, for gainful returns and income / profit and to carry out all such activities related to the objects of the Society.
- 4.12. To initiate any activity that facilitates financial self reliance of the community such as micro-credit, micro-loan and micro- entrepreneurship initiatives and employment generation.
- 4.13. To purchase or take on lease any freehold, leasehold or other property (*movable or immovable*) or any estates or interests wherever and any rights, privileges or easements over or in respect of property or in building and any real or personnel property or rights whatsoever which may be necessary for or may be convenient for use or which may enhance the value of the property of the Society and also to construct upon any premises acquired for the Society and/or to alter, add to help in repair or replace such property.
- 4.14. To carry on publicity and propaganda for the purpose of building awareness of public opinion with regard to the scope, importance and needs of Trade, Commerce, Vocations, Services and Industry being pursued by community.
- 4.15. To organize, participate, encourage, undertake, sponsor, promote, assist, run, conduct, hold, guide and manage projects, programs, conferences, symposiums, seminars, workshops, shows, exhibitions, dramas, promotional events, festivals, competitions etc. to achieve the objects of the Society.
- 4.16. To establish facilities for and to impart education and training and conduct test on materials, equipments and devices for use by such training centers. To set up institutions to advance and propagate education or useful knowledge in all spheres and to work in collaboration with other institutions of heritage conservation, art, theatre, schools, educational institutes, technical training institutes etc. for dissemination of knowledge and education related to all spheres of social and human
