Exparte Order

June 1, 2018

- The Complainants have booked apartments in the Respondent's project 'Rupji Vedant'
 (hereinafter referred to as the said project) situated at Kurla, Mumbai. The Complainants alleged
 the Respondent has not handed over the possession of their apartments, till date. Therefore,
 they want to withdraw from the said project and prayed that the Respondent be directed to
 refund the total amount paid by them along with interest.
- 2. Respondent failed to appear on the first date of hearing. On the second date of hearing held on April 11, 2018, learned Counsel for the Respondent submitted that a litigation is pending pertaining to the said project in the Hon'ble High Court, Bombay. Further, she submitted that no construction activity is going on as of now and that the Respondent is in the process of bringing another financer on board to complete the said project.

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- 3. In view of the above facts, in accordance with the principles of natural justice, since the project has been stalled for too long, the Respondent is directed to refund the total amount paid by the Complainants in accordance with the terms and conditions of the allotment letters/booking form, within 30 days from the date of this Order.
- 4. Consequently, the matters are hereby disposed of.
