Dear Sir,

The Energy Conservation Building Code (ECBC) was developed by Bureau of Energy Efficiency, which defines norms and standards of energy performance for various components of new commercial buildings and takes into account the various climatic zones in the country. To implement the ECBC in an effective way, several bi-lateral programmes are being implemented by BEE. One such project on energy efficiency improvements in commercial buildings is being implemented under UNDP-GEF-BEE project.

The UNDP-GEF project assists in the implementation and operationlization of the ECBC through a comprehensive and integrated approach with the focus on strengthening of the institutional capacities at various levels; developing technical expertise and awareness among key partners; ECBC demonstration projects in five climatic zones of the country; formulating fiscal and regulatory incentives for investors; and knowledge sharing and learning.

In order to facilitate the implementation of ECBC in the State, UNDP has prepared a Fiscal & Regulatory Study Report for the State. This study was commissioned to analyse the current regulatory and financial mechanism for ECBC implementation, identify the state specific gaps for adoption of ECBC and suggest state specific strategies including policies and financial incentives for adoption of ECBC under the UNDP-GEF-BEE.

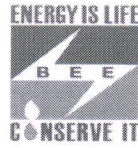
