Respected Sir,

We hereby refer to detailed meeting and representations discussed in your office in the meeting conducted on 28.06.2022 between CREDAI-MCHI developers and representatives of AAI team working on the finalization of CNS-equipment's, approach procedures and technical studies for Navi Mumbai international Airport. Firstly, we were happy to understand the stage at which the ongoing studies have reached and AAI team pointed out that it was the location of the Third Radar that needed a joint consensus between the stakeholders CIDCO and NMIAL (the airport operating agency) to take things forward and allow for studies to be completed and release of heights above 55.0 mtr AMSL.

We have thereafter visited the office of CIDCO where we have understood that CIDCO and NMIAL have jointly approved of the location of Third Radar at **Dilawale Island** in Navi Mumbai and communicated vide email to AAI team/representatives who have also visited this new location recently.

Thus, now since the location of all three CNS-equipment's (radar) is finalized we request you to expedite the process of finalization of studies, finalization of new CCZMP and release of the heights beyond 55mtr AMSL through NOCAS website.

CREDAI-MCHI humbly submit that Navi-Mumbai development has deeply been affected and many developers, existing members under redevelopment projects are hoping that AAI team as per discussion in meeting dated 28.06.2022 provides reliefs to ongoing project at earliest by release of heights beyond 55.0 mtr AMSL.

We hope that our above request will be considered and necessary action will be taken in this regard at the earliest.
