Sub: Issues/Suggestions for MPCB affecting the real estate sector and Infrastructure Industry

Respected Sir,

There are certain serious concerns in the functioning of the MPCB Department as mentioned below:

1. Delay in CC and CAC Meeting: We would like to bring to your kind attention that more than 500 cases are pending with MPCB for CTE & CTO permissions. There have been no hearings scheduled in the last three months to appraise the projects. We humbly request that the hearing be scheduled at the earliest. Most of the cases are done with scrutiny & are still pending with documents/details demanded from project proponents like (audited balance sheet, OC and old documents which are at times 20 years old) this are just few examples. This documentation does not affect any environmental norms neither are related with the jurisdiction.

Further, cases are specifically selected and seniority of case is not taken in to consideration, because of this practice, there has been lot of pending and backlog of cases

- **2. Validity of CTE & CTO permissions:** We humbly request to ensure that the validity of CET and CTO should be extended equal to the validity of EC.
- **3.** Penalties Imposed not as per the Guidelines: In recent times heavy penalties are being imposed by MPCB which is not as per the guidelines of CPCB. For eg. In Industries/Projects acquired through the NCLT route provision of penalty does not exist. In certain cases, old EC has been transferred to a new developer as directed by the SEIAA of Maharashtra since there was no process for the surrender of EC. In such cases MPCB has levied heavy penalties on the old EC which is no more valid.
- 4. One Time Permanent Permission by the CTO: In cases of all Real Estate projects the CTO should be granted as one-time Permanent permission and no renewal revalidation condition should be applied as the developer hands over the project to Society and it is an unnecessary burden on the Societies to comply for renewal every year.
- 5. Submission of Bank Guarantees: The condition of submission of Bank guarantees for CTE & CTO should be waived as CTO is only granted after all EC Conditions are met. The amount of bank Guarantees are arbitrarily decided and there is no defined process of reversing them once the Project is handed over to the Society. Due to this Crores of Rupees of Capital of developers across Maharashtra is lying blocked in the form of Bank Guarantees which directly affects the economy of the State.
