Subject: Request for Extension of the Amnesty Scheme for Penal Fees for Violating Combined Consent Regime Prescribed under the Air/Water Act Due to Election Code of Conduct

Ref: Circular bearing No. BO/MPCB/AS(T)/Circular/B-240227FTS0039 dated 27/02/2024

Respected Sir,

We are writing to bring to your attention a concern regarding the Amnesty Scheme dated February 27, 2023. Given the imposition of the election code of conduct and the ongoing electoral process, many individuals and organizations have been unable to avail themselves of the benefits offered by the scheme.

The code of conduct has imposed certain restrictions and limitations that have hindered effective communication and the ability of stakeholders to take full advantage of the amnesty period. As a result, a significant number of potential beneficiaries have missed the opportunity to benefit from this well-intentioned initiative.

Under the amnesty scheme, the penalty charges are reduced from 5 times to 2 times for the Red Category, from 3 times to 1 time for the Orange category, and no penalty shall be levied for the Green Category. This scheme was applicable from 1st March 2024 to 31st May 2024.

In light of the above, we respectfully request an extension of the Amnesty Scheme. Extending the deadline would provide the affected parties with a fair chance to comply with the scheme's requirements and benefit from its provisions. This extension would not only support environmental compliance but also ensure that the scheme achieves its intended objectives without being impacted by the external constraints posed by the election period.

We trust that you will consider this request favorably, understanding the unique circumstances and the potential positive impact of an extension. Your support in this matter will be greatly appreciated by all concerned stakeholders.
